## ABOUT US

Campbell Park Elementary opened in 1960 in its current location on Seventh Avenue S in St. Petersburg. The school was razed and rebuilt in 2003 offering classes in a state-of-the-art facility. Due to a federal grant, the school became a Marine Science Center, and the new facility was constructed with the marine science theme. The front office area houses a saltwater aquarium along with a marine science-themed mosaics. Two of the school's specialized classrooms are a Marine Science Lab and a Spanish Lab. Campbell Park Elementary is a Title I school, which gives students additional support, particularly in reading and math.
