Seventy-Fourth Street Elementary has been serving the families of the Tyrone area since the mid-'50s. It has grown in stages as the population of the area grew. Recent updates and renovations include the replacement of air-conditioning units in all classrooms in buildings 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, upgraded technology wiring in all classrooms, updated exterior lighting and the addition of fencing enclosing the entire campus. Seventy-Fourth Street Elementary is a Title I and Reading First school, which provides additional support for students in both reading and math.
